



# ***Raysfield Schools***

## ***Smoking***

### **AIM:**

- The smoking policy seeks to create a healthier working and learning environment for all school users by promoting non-smoking as a healthier lifestyle choice.
- No smoking is permitted on the whole School site. This includes e cigarettes.
- Smoking issues are addressed as part of the school's drug education programme, which is delivered within the Personal, Social and Health Education curriculum.

### **WHO?**

- This policy applies to all staff, pupils, visitors, parents/carers, people on the school site, volunteers, etc.

### **WHEN?**

- This policy applies during school hours and out of school hours (including fund raising/social events, e.g. sports day, school fair)

### **WHERE?**

- This policy applies to the school premises and grounds, and all school trips.

### **COMMUNICATION AND IMPLEMENTATION:**

- The school aims to ensure that no smoking takes place on the school site. The policy is implemented by involving the whole school community, including staff, governors, pupils, parents/carers and others.
- A range of responses and procedures may be required if someone does not follow the policy. For example: a verbal request to stop smoking.

### **SUPPORT:**

- The school recognises that smokers will be required to make the most adjustments through adopting this policy. Should any individuals wish to access support services the school has the information available about smoking cessation services (also available from GPs).

### **LINKS:**

- The policy links to this school's drug education policy.

**EVALUATION:**

- The policy will be reviewed alongside the school's drug education policy.
