## COVID UPDATE

Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> June

Dear Parents and Carers,

In Friday's letter, we shared that Public Health South Gloucestershire expected us to see a few more cases. Today I can confirm that there has been three more confirmed cases over the weekend. Two of these have been confirmed on a PCR test.

- One more case in Reception.
- Two cases in Year 5, resulting in us closing the Year 5 bubble.

Our Year 5 bubble must now self-isolate up to and including **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> July**. The reception case will not alter the self-isolation period.

To confirm the advice from Public Health, please do try and keep self-isolating siblings separate where possible, I know this can be a challenge within a household, but this variant is highly contagious and able to spread swiftly amongst our community.

All bubbles which have been closed, have now been deep cleaned including the Year 5 bubble which was cleaned today. Many thanks to our cleaning company for responding so quickly and prepared to work during their weekend.

Tomorrow I will be consulting with our local authority and Public Health South Gloucestershire to ensure there are no further steps the school needs to take. After brief consultation today, they are still advising the cases can be traced back to our reception cohort and we should remain open for bubbles who have not been impacted (Years 1, Year 2 and Year 6). If there are any changes to this, I will communicate them with you.

Please be mindful that information, re-organisation and safe preparation for our school to continue to operate is a challenging an ongoing activity, which is communicated to parents when appropriate and action is needed for example self-isolation. We thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter. Working as a team, will help us overcome this time together.
